B. TECH. 1ST YEAR ADMISSION

Eligibility for admission is decided by the rules given in the Prospectus of KEAM 2018 published by the Commissioner for Entrance Exams, Govt. of Kerala and the amendments issued by Government from time to time.

Govt. Quota

Academic Requirements:

- 1. Rank secured in the entrance exam conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Exams is mandatory.
- 2. Pass the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Examination, with 50% marks in Mathematics separately and 50 % marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together.
- 3. If the candidate has not studied Chemistry, the marks obtained in Computer Science shall be considered.
- 4. If the candidate has not studied Chemistry and Computer Science, the marks obtained in Biotechnology shall be considered.
- 5. If the candidate has not studied Chemistry, Computer Science and Biotechnology, the marks obtained in Biology shall be considered.

Relaxation of marks:

- The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination.
- 2. SEBC / OEC/ Persons with Disabilities (PD) will have a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination. They need only 45% marks in the case of Mathematics and 45% marks in the case of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together.

NRI Quota

- 1. Candidates who have passed higher secondary (or equivalent) examination, with 45% marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together.
- 2. Entrance Rank is not required.

B. TECH 2ND YEAR LATERAL ENTRY ADMISSION

Eligibility for admission is decided by the rules given in the Prospectus for B.Tech. LATERAL ENTRY Course- 2018-2019 to be published by the Director of Technical Education, Govt. of Kerala.

Academic Requirements:

- 1. As per the rank list prepared based on Entrance Examination conducted by the Joint Controller of Technical Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram.
- 2. Candidates who have passed Diploma in Engineering/ Technology awarded by any State Board of Technical Education, or Institutions under Govt. of India after undergoing regular course of 3 years are eligible for writing the Entrance Examination.
- 3. The admission will be subject to regulations of the University.
- 4. Maximum age as on the last date of submission of application will be 30 Years.
