**Re: UG/PG Paramedical and Physiotherapy Courses Admission
2019-20 - Admission Procedure for admitting candidates
under NRI quota & Minority quota - Order issued on
01.07.2019**

ORDER

The Associations (Self Financing Paramedical Managements Association & Self Financing Physiotherapy Colleges Management Association) & Individual Paramedical/ Physiotherapy Colleges are hereby directed to comply the directions contained in Para 8 of the Judgement dated 11.06.2018 in WP (C) No. 14007 of 2018 regarding NRI admission and the sponsorship.

“It is necessary to satisfy the above definition that an applicant should depend upon the relatives specified therein, who should be working abroad. One of the documents produced as Exhibit P19 shows that the petitioner was the nephew of the person who is shown as the ‘Sponsor’. He does not state that the petitioner is a dependent of his. He has only stated that he would sponsor the education of the petitioner. The said statement alone does not satisfy the requirements of dependency that is contemplated under Section 2 (0) of the Act”

Hence the sponsorship certificate should specify that the applicant is a dependent of the sponsor.

Some Paramedical/physiotherapy colleges have submitted the Minority certificates issued by the National Commission for minority educational institutions.

“As per the section 2(d) of the Kerala State Commission for Minorities Act 2014 read with notifications on “minority communities” issued by the Central Government in terms of section 2© of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992, “Minority” means the following communities:

- 1. Muslims*
- 2. Christians*

3. *Sikhs*
4. *Buddhists*
5. *Zoroastrians (Parsis)*
6. *Jains*

There shall not be any sub community for admission to Paramedical / Physiotherapy Colleges. The admission shall only be for the Christian Community. The same is reiterated in G.O (Ms) No. 10/2019/H&FWD dated 20.01.2019. The Association is also directed to obtain the certificate issued by the revenue authorities to substantiate the right of claim of admission under Minority quota.

All Paramedical / Physiotherapy colleges are hereby directed to comply the above instructions.
